Fill in a form (or get someone to do it for you) and hand it in to one of the people named on the entry form by 6pm on Wednesday, September 11th at the latest. No entries will be accepted after that date, and no entries will be accepted on the day of the Show.

Bring your exhibits to the Village Hall on show day, Saturday September 14th between 8.00am and 10.45am. You can come back after 2.00pm to see the show. Cups are presented at 4pm and prize money is distributed from 4:15pm. All exhibits can be removed from 4:15pm and must be collected by 5:00pm.

Below are the classes for young people:

The John Smith Cup

(for young people aged 7 years and under)
