If you enter several classes and score more points than anyone else in your section, you win a cup and can keep it for one year.

(Prizes are: £1.50 and 3 points for first, £1.00 and 2 points for second and 50p and 1 point for third.)

Fill in a form (or get someone to do it for you) and hand it in to one of the people named on the entry form by **6pm on Wednesday, September 8th** at the latest. No entries will be accepted after that date, and no entries will be accepted on the day of the Show.

Bring your exhibits to the Village Hall on show day, Saturday September 11th between 8.00am and 10.45am. You can come back after 2.00pm to see the show. Cups are presented at 4pm and prize money is distributed from 4:15pm. All exhibits can be removed from 4:15pm and must be collected by 5:00pm.

Below are the classes for young people:

The John Smith Cup

(for young people aged 7 years and under)

- 90 Any Fruit/Vegetable/Flowers, e.g. bunch of radish, lettuce, tomatoes, beans, nasturtiums.
You must have grown them yourself.

The Jean Dunn Cup

(for young people aged 7 years and under)

- 91 Make a small bug house.
92 Potato prints, paper size A4.
93 Animal made out of fruit and/or vegetables.
94 Drawing or painting of 'Nature', paper size A4.

The Buck Trophy

(for young people aged 8 to 12 years)

- 95 Any Fruit/Vegetable/Flowers, e.g. bunch of radish, lettuce, tomatoes, beans, nasturtiums.
You must have grown them yourself.

The Fred Lines Cup

(for young people aged 8 to 12 years)

- 96 Make a pizza with a face topping (base can be homemade or bought).
97 Photograph of your hobby, 15x10cm (6x4").
98 Make a scarecrow, max height 1 metre.
99 Jam jar arrangement of garden flowers and greenery.
100 Decorated hard-boiled egg.
